- The Crossing Golf Course and Club House is a challenging 18 hole course with rolling hills interesting greens and just the right amount of sand to keep golfers on their toes as well as an excellent dining experience whether you are an avid golfer or not. It is located at 4490 Hwy 212 W, Montevideo.

## Montevideo Parks

- 1. **Smith Park** is Montevideo's premier picnicking and gathering location. It is located across from City Hall. There are volleyball and horseshoe courts sheltered by its many majestic trees. Also there is a large playground for the kids.
- 2. Lagoon Park has ten campsites, eight with water and electrical hookups and provides modern bathroom and shower facilities. Availability is on a "first come first basis." There is a 9-hole Disc Golf course that weaves along the river bends, giving as much of a sight-seeing adventure as a game if disc golf.
- **3. Wildwood Park** boasts nature trails which wind along the Chippewa River, providing an ideal hiking ambience.
- 4. Windom Park Recreation Area is the newest park. It is a 25-acre park which features four tennis courts, baseball field, sand volleyball court, basketball court, playground equipment, picnic shelter and a hard surface walking path. Wind Park also houses Montevideo's Outdoor Swimming Pool Complex, complete with a 151-foot waterslide, and wading pool. Windom Park Recreation Park is located on the North Third Street and Ashmore Avenue.
